

Villars Bay Resort & Guiho's Ice Fishing Derby

The 2019 fish derby, presented by the Navy League Branch Timmins, will be held on Saturday, March 23rd, 2019.

Entry fee \$50.00 with your chance for 1st Place to win an 8X10 Completely Finished Ice Hut, 2nd Place \$500.00 cash and other Prizes.

1. By entering the Derby, all participants declare an understanding of all tournament rules and agree to abide by them.
2. Registration will be accepted until 5pm on Friday March 22nd 2019
3. For identification, either a Fishing License or Drivers license is required and must be provided when getting markers Saturday Morning. **ALL** Anglers Participating **MUST** Check with Hosts at the Ramp Area in front of Villars Bay Resort.
4. Participants must sign a waiver at the time of registration and understand these Rules.
5. Any participants breaking any of the Derby rules and/or any applicable Ont laws will be disqualified with no refund
6. All participants will abide by the Ontario Fishing Regulations and each participant is responsible for their own actions.
7. Anglers will drill their own holes.
8. Fishing will begin at 8am and end at 4:00 pm, Saturday March 23rd 2019.
9. No one is allowed to put a line in the water under any circumstances before 8am on the day of the derby.
10. All Derby participants must mark their fishing pole, stick, tip up etc with what is given at the time of check in, and must keep it visible for the entire Derby. All holes must be fished on the ice outside of fishing huts.
11. Once a fish is caught you must bring it immediately to the judging area and a Derby Official will measure the length of the fish and the time it was caught. The longest eligible fish wins the grand prize.
12. In case of a tie, time of catch will be the deciding factor. The earliest eligible fish caught will win the Grand Prize.
13. All prizes are final and no cash substitutions or prize exchange will be allowed.
14. Registration form is valid **ONLY** after payment is received.
15. All species of sport fish will be eligible to win. Live bait is permitted; however, all baits and hooks must meet applicable Ontario Fishing Regulations.
16. You are responsible for your safety and actions, at all times before, during and after the tournament.
17. Each entrant, upon registration to compete in the Derby, agrees that he/she will not hold the Sponsors or Hosts liable for any kind of accident that might occur during this tournament.
18. If conditions occur which are found to be dangerous to Derby participants before the start of the Derby, the Hosts will have the right to cancel the Derby and award all prizes based on a random draw.
19. If conditions occur which are found to be dangerous to Derby participants during the Derby, the Hosts will have the right to deem the Derby complete and all prizes will be awarded based on the leader board of fish caught at the time of completion of the Derby and/or using a random draw for any remaining prizes at the Hosts' sole discretion.
20. All participants must do their utmost to exhibit good sportsmanship conduct at all times during the Derby.
21. Fish must be live when brought to the Derby Officials. (Fins Moving) After recording the details the angler may release the fish back into the lake via provided opening (hole) or keep the fish for harvest if stressed. Live wells are recommended. Containers **MUST** have sufficient water in them prior to commencement of fishing.
22. **NO** alcoholic beverages will be allowed during the Derby with a good chance of the MNR/Police visiting.
23. Contestants suspected of consuming alcohol or drugs immediately prior to, or during the event, will not be allowed in the fishing area or will be ejected by the Host security personnel.
24. All rules are subject to interpretation by the Hosts, at their sole discretion.
25. Registrations cannot be transferred.
26. Any participant under the age of 16 years **MUST** be accompanied by an adult to collect any prizes.
27. This is a not for profit event, we want everyone to HAVE FUN with their Family and friends and MAKE MEMORIES.
